Dr. Hans Malmström is Professor and Chair of the Division of General Dentistry, Director of the Advanced Education in General Dentistry program and Director of Continuing Dental Education, at the University of Rochester Eastman Dental Center, Rochester, New York. He is the former Chair of the Department of General Dentistry at Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia.

Dr. Hans Malmström graduated from the University of Gothenburg School Dentistry in Sweden and completed a two-year GPR program at the University of Connecticut. He is a consultant to the commission of dental accreditation postdoctoral general dentistry, an actual member in ADA, ADEA, AACD and IADR.

He has extensive experience in clinical research including dental materials, especially composite and adhesive agents, analgesics, halitosis and dental implants. He has several publications in peer reviewed dental journals.
